THE BRICK FACADE ON THE BUILDING WAS DISCUSSED. THE BUILDING OWNER HAS MADE REPAIRS. MS. MOORE REQUESTED PERMISSION FOR A 35' X 35' OUTDOOR BEER GARDEN BEHIND GAME ON BAR & GRILL. MOTION BY HACK, SECONDED BY MARCH, TO AWARD THE 2017 SIDEWALK PROJECT TO J & J NEWELL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,960.25, PROVIDING THE SCOPE OF WORK WILL BE LOWERED TO MATCH THE VILLAGE BUDGETED AMOUNT. HACK, MARCH, JONES, HAMM, AND BOWDEN VOTING AYE; MOTION CARRIED.

TRUSTEE JONES STATED THAT THE INSURANCE REP HAS NOT RETURNED WITH THE ANSWERS TO THE QUESTIONS THE BOARD HAD ASKED. HE REQUESTED THAT THE INSURANCE REP COME BACK TO A BOARD MEETING.
